

PSA. 137:1-6 A MOMENT OF WEAKNESS AND A LIFETIME OF REGRET

Importance of a single moment • Eternally hangs in balance
ESAU, forgot true riches of birthright.
(They still weep bitterly)

ADAM + EVE - saw descendants fight,
sicken, drunk, lust, murder, die.
Pain, toil, sorrow = lifelong regret
Their open eyes - saw only regret -

→ The importance of a single decision
Life + death, Happiness + Sorrow
are poised on a single moment.

DAVID + BATHSHEBA - David shamed ^{Before} Israel
① Tamar humbled ② Amnon slain
③ Absalom's treachery ④ David flees.
⑤ Shimei curses ⑥ Absalom slain
⑦ Baby dies = "How long must I Regret?"

SAUL - Offers sacrifice, spares Agag, Pursues David, visits witch - dies in suicide

DENOMINATIONS - took wrong fork in the road. Lost their message ^{ISRAEL = "Let His Blood be upon us."} Scattered.

PERSONAL CONVICTIONS - Paul = "I press.. Mark.. Marry my wrong person. Left good strong church and lost family, fortune + peace. Not tithe.

AARON BURR - College + conviction = "God, let me alone - Sets in church = odd. God obeyed - request.

False doctrine = "Sons of God.", "Restitution".

Jim B — y = "Tell others - stay in church".
